



## Faecal-oral diseases and ‘Sanitary Revolutions’- the long view

### **Location and transport**

The conference will be held in room East 2 (first floor) at the [West Hub](#), which is located [here](#). The West Hub is a 30-minute walk from Cambridge city centre via the Coton footpath, or a short bus ride from the city centre on bus routes 4, 8, U1, and X3.

If you are travelling to the West Hub from Cambridge train station, the [U1](#) is the best public transport option - it runs every 30 minutes from the station stop 8. Alight at the ‘West Cambridge’ stop. Taxis are a 10-15 minute ride (£10-£15).

If you are driving you can use the Madingley Road [Park & Ride](#) which is a short walk or bus ride (U1) from West Hub.
